Cleanflow Environmental Solutions is committed to:

- ✓ Identifying hazards and assessing the risks posed by asbestos containing materials on all sites where we carry out work.
- ✓ The removal of asbestos from the site where it is assessed as posing a high, risk or as part of planned upgrade.
- ✓ Where removal of asbestos is impractical, due to extent of contamination, fencing the site to prevent access and erecting appropriate signage to advise the public
- ✓ Ensuring safe work procedures for asbestos removal works meets the required standards.
- ✓ Managing remaining asbestos in accordance with legislative requirements and best practice to ensure risks of exposure to asbestos fibers are controlled.
- ✓ Providing appropriate documentation on site to ensure the risk from asbestos is minimized to acceptable levels.
- ✓ Managing data and reporting of all information relating to asbestos management
- ✓ Consulting with all stakeholders and providing information and training to employees on the risk and management of asbestos
- ✓ Monitoring the health of employees subject to exposure of asbestos fibers
- ✓ Maintaining all records as required by legislation.
